**APPLICATION TO BECOME A SHAREHOLDER/UNSECURED LOAN NOTE HOLDER**

By becoming a shareholder you will have one equal vote in the IPS (Industrial and Provident Society) that is called the Nailbourne Community Store Association Limited, at general meetings. No-one can have more than one share and one vote however much they have paid for their share. The minimum for a share is £10. We are happy to accept any amount above that for your share.

By becoming an unsecured loan note holder in the NCS you are agreeing to help us with funding for a minimum period of 7 years. The minimum amount for an unsecured loan note is £100. There is no upper limit. You may have as many loan notes as you wish. It is the committee's intention to repay the notes as soon as practical.

**An unsecured loan note does not carry a vote but does entitle you to speak at general meetings**

You must be 18 years of age or over to be eligible to become a shareholder or unsecured loan note holder.
